Statement from U.S. Agriculture Coalition for Cuba on House introduction of Cuba Trade Act

WASHINGTON – **Devry Boughner Vorwerk**, chairwoman of the **U.S. Agriculture Coalition for Cuba (USACC)**, made the following statement today on the introduction of the Cuba Trade Act of 2015 by Rep. Tom Emmer (R-MN) in the U.S. House of Representatives:

"The U.S. Agriculture Coalition for Cuba has been vocal in our support for the Cuba Trade Act as it was recently introduced in the U.S. Senate, and we applaud the bipartisan coalition that today introduced mirror legislation in the U.S. House. This bill represents another important step toward ending the embargo and creating new economic opportunity for agriculture in both our nations. The USACC encourages Congress to finish work on bipartisan legislation as soon as possible and fully modernize U.S. policy toward Cuba by ending the embargo."
