• Determine the scope of request to FDA (dried or fluid forms, other restrictions)

- Secure broad industry support (NMPF, ADPI, state dairy associations) for request to FDA
- Pre-meeting with FDA Commissioner's office & CFSAN to determine receptivity
- Develop data/evidence on widespread use of MF milk in imported cheese
- Develop communication strategy to advance advocacy
- Recruit members, state dairy associations and state departments of agriculture in cheese states and federal policy makers to lobby FDA

Expand global market opportunities for cheese

- Determine TRQ quantities with Segment Board for cheese that ensures improved dairy access equal to or better than CPTPP and EU-Japan EPA and present to USTR, USDA and Congressional trade committees
- Support MOU between USDA and FDA that facilitates export certification process in a timely manner
- Continuous review with IDFA Trade Committee on FTA priority countries and present country priorities to USTR, USDA, and key Congressional offices
- Brief congressional allies to elevate cheese's profile in future trade agreements
- Work with coalitions, state dairy associations and members to lobby

FMMO

Modernize FMMO system to encourage greater innovation and investment

- Class III and Class IV and Spot market rules issues working group formed
- Provide technical support to working group and develop best practices
- Data supporting industry priorities is developed
- Longer term issues working group established

Advocate for changes to immigrant visas that accommodate the needs of the dairy industry

• Advocate for IDFA's Immigration Task Force priorities through the Agriculture Workforce Coalition (AWC) and Essential Worker Immigration Coalition (EWIC)

Defend cheese's role in dairy food group in the 2020 DGA

- Advocate Dietary Guidelines Advisory Committee (DGAC) consider new scientific evidence on the role of higher fat dairy in a healthy diet
- Written comments and testimony to DGAC include evolving science on milkfat
- Work with NDC on review of full fat dairy research
- Coordinate testimony and comments with NDC, NMPF and members
- Analyze DGAC report, meet with USDA and file comments to support dairy role and higher fat recommendations in the DGA

Protect members from frivolous lawsuits related to natural cheese

- Enactment of legislation that inserts a definition of "natural cheese" supported by our members in federal statute
- Outreach to HELP member offices to pave the way for utilizing the "hotline" process in the Senate to pass the bill
- Develop leverage that will help overcome Chairman Pallone's opposition in the House by generating support from House Democrats
- Assure FDA technical consultation with Congress on CURD Act definition is supportive

- Near term, revisiting current formula in anticipation of make allowance hearing after USDA-commissioned cost study released

Product forms

- Class III
 - Add 640# blocks?
 - Eliminate barrels?
 - Replace cheddar with mozz or add mozz?
 - Change basis of whey valuation?
 - Add grade A whey?
 - Convert to other reference (condensed whey, protein only, etc)
- Class IV
 - Add SMP?



Class III / IV Elements Under Review



- Price Discovery Mechanism
 - Survey vs. CME?
 - Concluded survey due to implications on futures
- Survey Criteria Refinement
 - Lengthen pricing timeframe for eligible sales?
 - Adjust national survey result to western base?
- Yields
 - Confirm yields in both Class III / IV formulas



Class III / IV Data Requests



- Survey to identify likely eligible volume if mozz added to Class III formula
 - Need to identify most common spec; would be limited to bulk
 (20# plus?) unshredded
- Identify cheddar reportable volume and geographic dispersion by form
- Identify degree of marketplace differentiation (price) between Grade A and Extra Grade whey
